**NOTES:**

1. *Italicized* courses satisfy both LCC and Texas State Core Curriculum requirements. Courses in (parentheses) indicate the course transfer equivalents at Texas State.
2. If two years of the same foreign language were not completed in high school, students must take 6-8 hours of the same foreign language.
3. If one year of general computer science was not completed in high school, students must take HP 2351 or its equivalent.
4. Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval.)
5. Students may elect to complete courses in a different sequence where possible, but should consult a counselor/advisor before doing so.
6. Upon completion of certain course requirements at Texas State, students may elect to send these hours back to LCC to be applied toward an associate's degree. This is commonly referred to as "reverse transfer."

## TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS

---

### UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit completed Texas Common Application form, \$40 application fee, and all credentials to the Texas State Undergraduate Admissions Office by the stated deadline (Fall-July 1, Spring-December 1, Summer I-May 1, Summer II-June 15).
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Undergraduate Admissions Office. Students must be eligible to return (e.g., free of suspension, dismissal, or enforced withdrawal) to all previous institutions regardless of grade point average (GPA) or degrees received.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required. In computing the GPA, grades of "A", "B", "C", "D", and "F" are computed as recorded. Grades of "W", "P", "Q", and "X" are disregarded and grades of "WF" and "I" are averaged as "F". Grades in non-transferable and technical/vocational courses are disregarded.

### ADMISSION TO THE RESPIRATORY CARE PROGRAM:

1. Complete University admission process prior to the May 1 department deadline. Acceptance to the University does not guarantee acceptance to the RC program.
2. Submit completed application form to the RC department chair. Applications to the program are accepted any time during the year.
3. Submit official copies of transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended to the RC department chair. The minimum acceptable GPA is 2.50.
4. Submit copies of all professional licensure and/or certifications held to the RC department chair.
5. Schedule a personal interview with the RC department chair.

It is strongly recommended that students present themselves for advising as soon as Respiratory Care has been selected as a major. Course offerings and sequencing are such that advising is recommended to avoid scheduling problems. All RC courses are lock-step, sequenced with offerings only once per year for most courses, and must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.

Student selection is made on the basis of expected successful completion of the curriculum (academic and clinical) and not on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, age, or national origin. Enrollment is limited by student faculty ratios in both academic and clinical phases of the program.
