NOTES:

3. If two years of the same foreign language were not completed in high school, students must take 6-8 hours of the same foreign language.
4. Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval).

5. Completion of this transfer planning guide will void eligibility for the state's Tuition Rebate Program. If additional courses not listed on this guide are attempted, students should acquaint themselves with the Excessive Hours statute and Texas State's tuition policy for these hours.

TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS

UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit completed application form and all credentials to the Undergraduate Admissions Office by the stated admission deadline (Fall-July 1, Spring-December 1, Summer I-May 1, Summer II-June 15).
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Undergraduate Admissions Office.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required.
4. Submit an application for on-campus housing, if required, or apply to live off campus.

ADMISSION TO TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM:

1. Junior standing (60 semester hours accumulated).
 2. Cumulative Texas State GPA of 2.50 or higher.
 3. Texas Higher Education Assessment (THEA) scores of at least 220 in writing and 230 in reading and mathematics or documentation of exemptions or equivalencies.
 4. Completion of the mathematics and science formative assessments.
 5. College level skills in reading, oral and written communication, critical thinking, and mathematics:
 - a. Reading: Successful completion of PHIL 1305 or its equivalent.
 - b. Oral Communication: Successful completion of COMM 1310 or its equivalent.
 - c. Written Communication: Grades of "C" or higher in ENG 1310 and 1320 or their equivalents.
 - d. Critical Thinking: Successful completion of PHIL 1305 or its equivalent.
 - e. Mathematics: A grade of "C" or higher in MATH 1315 or 1319 or 2417 or 2471 for Interdisciplinary Studies majors or successful completion of the mathematics requirement in the selected major for high school and all-level certificates.
 6. Grade of "C" or higher in CI 3310 or equivalent (EDUC 1301).

ADMISSION TO STUDENT TEACHING:

1. Admission to Teacher Education.
2. A Texas State GPA of 2.5 or higher.
3. Validation of required pre-student teaching field experiences.
4. A grade of "C" or higher in all assigned courses in the professional sequence prior to student teaching.
5. A GPA of at least 2.50 in the teaching field(s) or specialization(s) with no grade below a "C".
6. Approval from the chair of the department of the student's major teaching field.
